

Scott P. Moore Rear Admiral, USN (Retired)

Rear Admiral (Retired) Scott Moore is founder and CEO of Karakoram Group (KGI), an international risk management firm which enables corporations to operate securely and safely in challenging global environments. Through KGI, he has created an organization of premier Special Operations leaders who successfully directed the nation's top counterterrorism units. Clients have included Exxon, Chevron, Parsons, Sesame Street, private equity groups and other private clients. A master of strategic planning and risk mitigation, Moore gained his insights during his 30-plus years as a Navy SEAL officer. He is known for his operational prowess, effective leadership and clear decision making.

As a former commander of Naval Special Warfare Development Group, he planned and directed over 2,000 missions in Afghanistan, Africa and the Middle East. He also commanded SEAL Team Two immediately following 9/11. His most public success was his on-scene command of the Captain Phillips rescue. Other critical roles include advising the President of the United States on counterterrorism while serving on the National Security Staff in the White House; devising regional strategies for the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff at the Pentagon; and coordinating NATO operations directly, while developing a strong rapport with top military leaders in Pakistan. Moore is also a master of employee assessment and placement from his time spent as the Navy Detailer, responsible for the career path of each SEAL officer. He finished his military career as the Deputy Commander at Naval Special Warfare Command, where he was responsible for training and equipping a 7000-person force. He also implemented over \$600 million in training facility modernization upgrades.

Prior to founding KGI, he was Managing Director for Prescient Edge, a Federal Risk Management and Intelligence Services company. He has held advisory roles and board positions on ADS, Asgard Partners, Wild Things and Bohemia Interactive. He currently serves as Chairman of SEALKids.

Moore is a native of Colorado Springs, Colorado. He holds a bachelor's degree from the U.S. Air Force Academy. He graduated with distinction from the Naval War College, earning a master's in National Security and Strategic Studies.
